This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking for a direction to the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge, (Special Court under SC & ST Atrocities Act) at Perambalur, Perambalur District to accept the surrender of the Petitioners herein concerned in Crime No.49 of 2022 pending on the file of the Inspector of Police, Kunnam Police Station, Perambalur District and consider the bail petition on the same day itself.

2.In view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and also taking into consideration of the possibility of misusing the pious intention of the Parliament against innocent persons, there shall be a direction to the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge, (Special Court under SC & ST Atrocities Act) at Perambalur, Perambalur District to accept the surrender of the Petitioners in Crime No.49 of 2022 pending on the file of the second respondent and consider the bail petition on the same day and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity to the victims under Section 15-A of the SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989. The petitioner shall surrender before the concerned Jurisdictional Court, within a period of fifteen days from the date of the receipt of a copy of this Order.

3. In view of the above, the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
