These petitions have been filed seeking to condone the delay of 1968 days in filing the petition to implead the legal representatives of deceased 2nd petitioner, to set aside the abatement caused due to the death of 2nd petitioner, and to bring on record the proposed petitioner herein as legal representatives of deceased 2nd petitioner.

2. Mr.C.Deivasigamani, learned counsel for petitioners herein submitted that pending Civil Revision Petition, 2nd petitioner died on 01.07.2016. He would submit that as the petitioner is a senior citizen, he is not able to get the particulars in time and he is unable to give instructions to his counsel. Hence, the delay of 1968 days arose in filing the above petitions and the delay is neither willful nor wanton. Hence, he has filed the above petitions.
