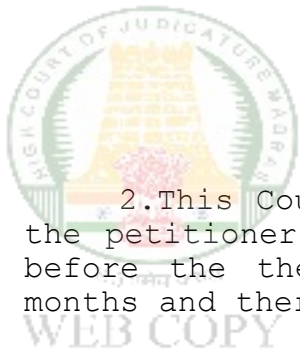

Order : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.S.HEMALATHA, Advocate for the petitioner and of MR.S.SANTHOSH, Govt. Advocate (Crl. Side) on behalf of the Respondent the court made the following order:-

This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner in Crl.O.P.No.1360 of 2022 dated 18.02.2022.



2. This Court, on 18.02.2022, while granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner imposed a condition that the petitioner should appear before the respondent police on Saturday for a period of two months and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.

3. On perusal of a report submitted by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) for the respondent/State shows that the petitioner had started complying the condition only from the first week of April and so far reported before the Investigating Officer for a period of four weeks. As per the conditional order passed by this Court, the petitioner has to report before the Investigating Officer for the remaining period of four weeks.

4. Considering the nature of offence, this Court is not inclined to relax the condition earlier imposed on the petitioner. Accordingly, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition stands dismissed.
