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The petitioner belongs to BC Community, the cut off mark for BC Community for viva-voce is 43.06 marks and as the petitioner has not secured the required marks, he was not called for the viva-voce.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has not scored the cut off mark required for selection, he was not within the zone of consideration and therefore, the question of considering the relief as such sought for in the writ petition does not arise at all.
