These petitions have been filed to suspend the sentence imposed on the petitioner/accused by the judgment dated 20.11.2020 in C.A.No.24 of 2020 on the file of the learned Sessions Judge, Fast Track Mahila Court, Namakkal, confirming the order of conviction and sentence dated 29.01.2020 passed in S.C.No.07 of 2019 on the file of the learned Additional Assistant Sessions Judge, Namakkal, and release the petitioner on bail and to exempt the petitioner from surrendering pending disposal of the above Criminal Revision Petition.

Today, when these petitions are taken up for hearing, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is surrendered before the trial Court and hence he seeks permission of this Court to not press these petitions. He has also made an endorsement in the Court bundle to that effect.
