These applications have been filed seeking to set aside the *ex parte* order dated 26.04.2022 passed against the defendants 4 to 7 in CS.No.351 of 2021.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the applicants/defendants 4 to 7 would submit that the suit summons were not served in person, but were served in the office of the CSI Coimbatore Diocese, Coimbatore and immediately thereafter the applicants have filed the written statements. However, this Court vide order dated 26.04.2022, set the applicants/defendants *ex parte*. Therefore, the learned counsel seeks to set aside the *ex parte* order.

3.Considering the submission made by the learned counsel appearing for the applicants/defendants 4 to 7 and in view of the fact already the applicants filed the written statement and in the interest of the justice, this Court feels it appropriate to set aside the *ex parte* order.
