Service Connection No.01-109-011-837 on the basis of petitioner's representation dated 09.08.2016 and also to forbear the second and third respondents from taking any action against the petitioner for illegal extraction of energy by the fifth respondent.

2.The learned Standing Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-TANGEDCO made a submission that the Electricity Service Connection has already been disconnected on 28.09.2016 itself. Therefore, the parties have to approach the Authorities for further action or for resolving the issues.

3.This being the factum informed, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the Competent Authorities for the purpose of redressal of his grievances if any exists.

4.With the abovesaid liberty, the writ petition stands disposed of. However, there shall be no order as to costs.
