ORDER

The petitioner is the mother of the detenu viz., Seenivasan S/o.Perumal, aged 28 years. The detenu has been detained by the third respondent by his order in C.M.P.No.6/Black Marketer/Salem City/2022 dated 20.04.2022, holding him to be a "Black Marketer", as contemplated under the Prevention of Black Marketing and Maintenance of Supplies of Essential Commodities Act, 1980 [Central Act 7 of 1980]. The said order is under challenge in this Habeas Corpus Petition.



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2. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the detention order passed against the detenu in C.M.P.No.6/Black Marketer/Salem City/2022 dated 20.04.2022, on the file of the third respondent is revoked *vide* G.O.Rt.No.181, Co-operation, Food and Consumer Protection (E1) Department, dated 16.05.2022 and produced a copy of the said order.

In view of the above, this petition is closed as it has become infructuous.
