This Petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed in Crl.O.P.No.25888 of 2021 dated 12.01.2022. The condition was that the First Petitioner has to appear before the Respondent Police on First and Fifteenth of every month at 10.30 a.m and the Second Petitioner has to report on every Saturday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the Respondent Police submits that the investigation has not been completed and prays that the condition imposed can be modified instead of totally relaxing the condition.



3. In view of the submission made by the Learned Counsel for the parties, the condition is modified to the fact that the First Petitioner is directed to appear before the Respondent Police on the first day of every English calendar month and the Second Petitioner is directed to appear before the Respondent Police on the alternative Sundays, until further orders.
