PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

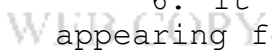
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest for the alleged offence under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 & 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.64 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side).

3. The case of the prosecution is that on 28.04.2022, there arose a wordy quarrel between the petitioners and the defacto complainant regarding usage of common pathway, in which, the petitioners alleged to have attacked the defacto complainant using his hands and threatened him with dire consequences. In the said attack, the defacto complainant sustained injuries. Thereby, the law enforcing agency registered a case against the petitioners.

4. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and the defacto complainant had sustained only simple injuries. Hence, the learned counsel prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
