



(4) The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that totally there are 9 accused and the petitioner is arrayed as A5. Due to previous enmity and rivalry, the occurrence had taken place. Learned Government Advocate [Crl.Side] also submitted that A1 is already booked under the Goondas Act by the Pallikaranai Police Station and the petitioner is a rowdy element. He would further submit that the investigation is pending as A4 is yet to be secured.

(5) Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that the investigation is pending as A4 is yet to be secured and that steps are being taken to detain A1 under the Act 14 of 1982, this Court is not inclined to grant the relief of bail to the petitioner.

(6) Hence, this Criminal Original petition stands dismissed.
