PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 7, 8, 11 (1), 12 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and 506(i) of the IPC in Crime No.05 of 2022, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner compelled the victim minor girl to love him. If the victim girl failed to love the petitioner, the petitioner threatened that he will pour acid on her face. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and no way connected with the alleged offence. Hence, he prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that the investigation is not yet completed and if the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail, there is a possibility that he will tamper the witnesses and hamper the investigation and hence he vehemently opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case that the petitioner misbehaved with the victim girl, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
