Prayer:- Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950, praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the Respondents, especially the First Respondent to re-fix the Petitioner's scale of pay eligible to Grade-II trade posts in the light of the rules framed pursuant to G.O.Ms. No. 234 Finance (pay-cell) department, dated 01.06.2009 & G.O.Ms. No.338 Finance (pay-cell) Department, dated 26.08.2010 making further revision of the scale of pay from Rs.5200-20200+2800 to Rs.9300-34800+4400 GP, as per the Letter No.63305/Pay Cell/2010-1 dated 08.11.2010 and G.O. Ms. No. 325, Finance (pay-cell) Department, dated 22.07.2013 and making the petitioner eligible to draw not only the difference in monetary benefits, but stepping up of his pay-scale, considering the Petitioner's recent /last representation dated 04.11.2015.
