PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 468 and 471 of IPC , in Crime No.95 of 2017, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. Totally there are five accused and the petitioner herein is A1. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner is a friend of the de-facto complainant and he introduced one Pannerselvam (A2) to him. The further case of the prosecution is that through the above said Pannerselvam, A3 to A5 had obtained loan for a sum of Rs.2,00,000/-; Rs.4,00,000/-; Rs.3,00,000/- respectively by pledging forged registration certificates of three cars, for which A1 and A2 stood as guarantors. Hence the complaint.



3.The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and the petitioner being the friend of the de-facto complainant and also Pannerselvam(A2), he has been implicated in this case. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the petitioner has introduced A2 to the de-facto complainant and for the loan obtained by A3 to A5 by pledging the forged documents of the vehicles, the petitioner along with A2 had stood as guarantors. Hence, he opposed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5.Considering the above facts and circumstances, this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Tiruppur, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and on further condition that:

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].



[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
