This Criminal Original Petition is filed for a direction to the first respondent to grant police protection to the petitioners for running their School in terms of Civil Court order of injunction dated 27.04.2022.

3. In view of the order of the Civil Court, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the respondent would submit that the protection can be ordered to be granted in terms of the order passed by this Court in Radhika Hari Vs. Commissioner of Police, reported in 2014(2) CTC 695.

4. Accordingly, the respondent/police is directed to grant protection in terms of the Civil Court order to the petitioner, as per the further terms mentioned in the above case cited supra.

5. In that view of the above, the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
