2. As per the judgment of Division Bench of this Court in the case of G.Prabakaran Vs. Superintendent of Police, Thanjavur District and others in Crl.O.P. (MD) No.13681, 13688 of 2017 etc., the respondent police have to conduct preliminary enquiry and register a case if the offence is made out and if the said exercise is not being carried out, the petitioner shall follow the procedures as mandated by the Division Bench from Clause 6 onwards i.e. to give a representation to the higher officials and thereafter, to file a private complaint under Sec.156(3) Cr.P.C.
