TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The Award is passed in terms of the compromise memo. A memo shall form part of the Award.

2. The Judicial Magistrate Fast Track (Magistrate Level 2), Ambattur is directed to issue cheque in favour of D.Saravanan for a sum of Rs.65,000/- as full and final settlement on filing a memo enclosing a copy of the Award. Award is passed accordingly.
