PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 465, 467, 471, 406, 420 of IPC, in Crime No.434 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with A1 collected a sum of Rs.7,00,000/- from the defacto complainant's father for getting allotment of house in the Slum Clearance Board. Later, they failed to hand over the house to the defacto complainant's father and cheated the amount to the tune of Rs.7,00,000/-. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner was only introduced the defacto complainant's father with A1 and he has nothing to with the alleged offence. Hence, he would pray for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) would raise strong objection stating that petitioner is the key person along with other accused collected and cheated more than two crores from the general public including the defacto complainant's father for getting house in the Slum Clearance Board. Hence, he vehemently opposed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. It is seen that the petitioner along with other accused persons had collected more than two crores from the general public for getting house in the Slum Clearance Board and cheated them. Therefore, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is very much required and this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
