Prayer : Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, pleaded to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other in the nature of writ, directing the respondent authority to give permission to conduct a Cultural program schedule to be held on 10.06.2022 between 06.00pm to 11.00pm in Pachanampatti Village, Muthunaickanpatti, Palaiyur Arulmigu Sree Adhi Throwpathiyamman Temple festival at Omalur Taluk, Salem District by considering the petitioner representation dated 20.05.2022.

O R D E R

The Writ Petition has been filed seeking to direct the respondent to permit the petitioner to conduct a Cultural program schedule to be held on 10.06.2022 between 06.00pm to 11.00pm in Pachanampatti Village, Muthunaickanpatti, Palaiyur Arulmigu Sree Adhi Throwpathiyamman Temple festival at Omalur Taluk, Salem District by considering the petitioner representation dated 20.05.2022.

2.Today when the matter is came up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) appearing for the respondent police produced an order dated 25.05.2022, stating that the respondent has already rejected the request of the





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(k) Organizers shall have to obtain all other required permission from the authorities concerned;

(l) Any other conditions as the authority concerned consider to impose according to the ground reality.

(m) since the respondent has apprehended law and order problem, even though permission is granted, once there is any sign of law and order problem or if any law and order situation commences, immediately the respondent will be at liberty to stop the programme forthwith and disperse the public and avoid any untoward incident.

4. The petitioner is also directed to ensure that the conditions are strictly complied with and also to ensure that no law and order problem is created in the course of conducting the programme. Further, the petitioner is directed to pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) to the respondent police towards bundobust charges.

5. Accordingly, this Writ Petition stands disposed of with the above directions. There shall be no order as to costs.
