PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest for the alleged offence under Section 381 of IPC, in Crime No.99 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 12.05.2022, the defacto complainant who is Vehicle Patrolling Officer in Indus Evergreen Management Security Pvt. Ltd, received a mail from the Cell Phone Tower Maintenance Team stating that 310 meters of Copper Wire worth about Rs.30,000/- was found missing from IV Floor, Rasi Building at Ponnaiyarajapuram. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He would further submit that the petitioner is ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed on him and would pray for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
