O R D E R

The petitioner herein is a Resolution Professional being aggrieved by the repeated complaint given by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent is before this Court invoking Section 482 of Cr.P.C seeking protection from coercive action by the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent. On hearing, the Learned Counsel for the petitioner and perusing the petition, this Court finds that the petitioner herein been subjected to complaints by 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent and therefore, he want a blanket order that, no coercive action should be taken against him.
