ORDER

WEB COPY This Civil Revision Petition has been preferred seeking direction for early disposal of the suit filed by the revision petitioner in OS.No.109/2019 pending on the file of the District Munsif Court, Tiruppur.

2. The revision petitioner who is the plaintiff has filed the suit for declaration of injunction. It is relied to learn that the suit is pending for framing of issues.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the plaintiff is a senior citizen who is 78 years old and taking into consideration of his age and other attending circumstances of the case, a direction should be given to the learned trial Judge for early disposal of the suit.
