The Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondent to grant permission to conduct the cultural programme of Adal Padal in Shri Mariyamman Thriviliya Festival even in "Korakuppam Village", Balakrishnapuram Post, Pallipet Taluk, Tiruvallur District from 06.06.2022 to 08.06.2022 especially for the dance program on 08.06.2022 by considering petitioner representation dated 01.06.2022.



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(i) if any untoward incident takes place, the organizers of the programme be made responsible for the same;

(j) the authority concerned shall videograph the entire programme at the cost of the applicant and submit the CD to the S.P concerned;

(k) Organizers shall have to obtain all other required permission from the authorities concerned;

(l) Any other conditions as the authority concerned consider to impose according to the ground reality".

5. The petitioner is also directed to ensure that the conditions are strictly complied with and also to ensure that no law and order problem is created in the course of conducting the programme. If there is any rival claim, the police is also directed to hear the other side before granting permission to the petitioner. Further, the petitioner is directed to pay a sum of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) to the respondent police towards bundobust charges.

6. The Writ Petition stands disposed of with the above directions. However, there shall be no order as to costs.
