PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

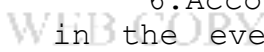
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 430, 379 of I.P.C. r/w Section 21 (5) of M & M Act, r/w Section 3 (2) of TNPPDL Act in Crime No.2838 of 2020, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and other accused had transported two units of river sand illegally by using a vehicle namely lorry bearing Registration No.TN-46K-2565, without any valid licence. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that already the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by this Court on 22.01.2021 on condition that the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.30,000/- as non-refundable deposit either through RTGS/NEFT or in cash or in favour of "The Tamil Nadu Advocate Clerk Association, Indian Bank High Court Branch". Accordingly, the petitioner deposited a sum of Rs.30,000/-. However, the petitioner was unable to execute two sureties as directed by this Court, since he suffered from viral fever. Therefore, the petitioner has again filed the present petition seeking for anticipatory bail.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the river sand involved is two units. Hence, he vehemently opposed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
