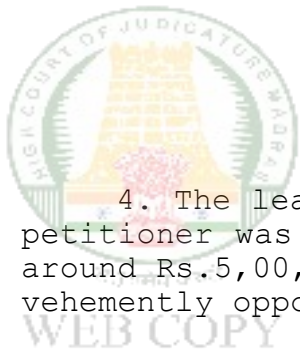
PETITION FOR BAIL ANTICIPATORY 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 381 and 506(i) of IPC in Crime No.121 of 2022, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant's father was running a bakery and he died on 12.07.2020. Thereafter, the defacto complainant took charge and looking after the business, though the business was going well no profits were found, hence she suspected the employees and fixed a spy camera and she found that the petitioner was taking money from the cash box for several times and so far as she was taken Rs.5,00,000/-. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner was working under the defacto complainant for the past 4 years. The defacto complainant suspected illegal intimacy with her deceased father and lodged the present complaint. Therefore, he prays anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the petitioner was working under defacto complainant bakery and she theft around Rs.5,00,000/- from the defacto complainant's bakery. Hence, he vehemently opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the above fact and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on her appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Madhuranthakam, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and on further condition that:

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].



[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
