PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

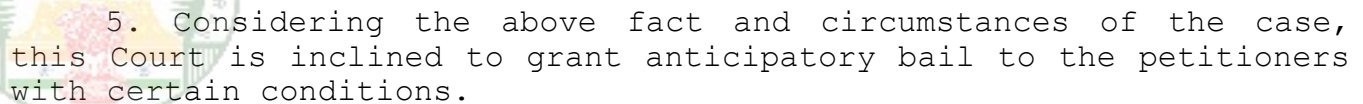
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 379 of IPC r/w Section 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act,1957,in Crime No.774 of 2021, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners were involved in illegal transportation of ½ unit of river sand by using bullock cart. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that already the petitioners were granted anticipatory bail by this Court on 06.01.2022 on condition that the petitioners shall deposit a sum of Rs.3,000/- to the credit of Registered Advocate Clerk Association, Ariyalur District, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the order. However, the petitioners were unable to deposit the said amount. Therefore, the petitioners have again filed the present petition seeking for anticipatory bail.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor admitted that the petitioners were earlier granted anticipatory bail by this Court. However, the petitioners have not executed the sureties as directed by Court.



[a] the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[c] the petitioners shall report before the respondent police on every Wednesday at 10.30 a.m, until further orders.

[e] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.
