This application has been filed to set aside the *ex parte* order dated 11.03.2022 in C.S.No.310 of 2021, passed against the 4th defendant on the file of this Court.

2. The learned counsel for the applicant/4th defendant would submit that though the respondents proposed for amicable settlement of the dispute, later due to some difference of opinion among the parties, no settlement has been arrived at and the same was informed to the Court. In the meantime, the applicant was set *ex parte* for not filing the written statement, it is neither wilful nor wanton, hence he seeks to set aside the *ex parte* order.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the respondents also has reported no objection for allowing this application.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances and submissions made by the parties, this Court feels it appropriate to set aside the *ex parte* order. Accordingly, this application stands allowed.
