PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Charging Exorbitant Interest Act, 2003 in Crime No. 125 of 2022, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant borrowed a sum of Rs.53,00,000/- from the petitioner and he had repaid Rs.50,00,000/-. Even then, the petitioner is demanding huge interest from the defacto complainant. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Therefore, he prays for grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the defacto complainant borrowed a sum of Rs.53,00,000/- from the petitioner and paid Rs.50,00,000/-. Subsequently, the petitioner had demanded a sum of Rs.19,00,000/- with interest. However, he vehemently opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
