PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 328 of IPC r/w 7, 20(1) of COTPA Act in Crime No.150 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.It is the case of the prosecution that the petitioners alleged to have transported 9092 Kgs of Tobacco products illegally in the TATA Motors Vehicle bearing registration No.TN-22-DH-1792. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is owner of the vehicle gave a vehicle for a rental purpose. He Would further submit that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the accused persons have illegally possessed 9092 Kgs of Tobacco products worth about Rs.62,00,000/-. The petitioner is arrayed as A4 and he is the owner of the vehicle and there is no change of circumstance after dismissal of previous anticipatory bail petition. Hence, he



vehemently opposed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also there is no change of circumstances after dismissal of previous anticipatory bail petition, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
