PRAYER:

Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. praying to enlarge the petitioners on bail in crime No.98 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER

The petitioners, who were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 23.05.2022 for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148 of IPC and Section 3 (1) of TNPPDL Act in crime No.98 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seek bail.

2. It is the case of the prosecution that the accused persons damaged a Government bus mirror on 23.05.2022 worth Rs.5,000/-Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he prays for grant of bail to the petitioners.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police would submit that there are totally six accused, in which the petitioners are arrayed as A3 and A4. He would further



submit that the accused persons damaged the mirror of a Government bus worth Rs.5,000/-. Hence, he vehemently opposed to grant bail to the petitioners.

5. Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the period of incarceration by the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their executing a separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two blood related sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Needamangalam and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. and 05.30 p.m. until further orders.

[c] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
