The above petitions are filed for condoning the delay of 82 days in filing the Review Applications.

2.In the affidavit filed in support of the condone delay petitions, the petitioners have submitted that though the revision had been disposed of on 24.02.2022, his counsel had not filed a copy application and despite several requests, he has not applied copy application. Thereafter, he had changed his counsel in the month of June 2022. He had applied for copy of the order and the same was received by him on 27.06.2022.
