2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that both the petitioners are none other than the father and daughter. In one case, the father has lodged a complaint as against his daughter and in another case, the daughter has lodged a complaint as against her father.

3. Both the complaints have been forwarded to the Revenue Divisional Officer/ Executive Manager, Chengalpattu to initiate proceedings under Section 107 of Cr.P.C and it is pending.

4. Considering the above, the Revenue Divisional Officer/Executed Magistrate, Chengalpattu is directed to issue notice to the petitioner in both the petitions and other parties if any and after giving them an opportunity of hearing, dispose of the same and pass appropriate orders in the manner known to law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. It is made clear that if any of the offence committed by any party, both the parties are at liberty to approach the first respondent or the learned Judicial Magistrate for appropriate relief.
