3. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have been falsely implicated in this case. That apart, the petitioners have been suffering incarceration from 19.04.2022. Therefore, he prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that there are totally 10 accused, in which, the petitioners are arrayed as A6 and A8. On the date of occurrence, there was a wordy quarrel between two groups in the cinema theatre. They started attacking each other with knife and abusing in filthy language, in which three persons were injured. He would further submit that five knives along with 25 MDMA Ecstasy (1.35 grams) tablets were recovered from the accused persons. He further submitted that the injured persons were discharged from the hospital on 19.04.2022.

5. Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case and co-accused were enlarged on bail and also the period of incarceration

undergone by the petitioners from the date of arrest ie., from 19.04.2022, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on his executing separate bond for a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only)** with **two blood related sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **XV Metropolitan Magistrate Court, George Town, Chennai** and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioners shall report before the respondent police twice daily at 10.30 a.m., and 04.30.p.m., until further orders;

[c] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**.

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
