The above petition is filed to condone the delay of 3082 days in re-presenting the papers in the above review petition.

4. A perusal of the plaint in both the matters, namely, O.S.No.146 & 147 of 1988 would indicate that although the schedule of properties shows different numbers however, the four boundaries that have been given is identical.

However, taking into consideration the fact that the review petition has been filed in time and as the issue in both the appeals have bearing on each other the delay is condoned.
