The detenu has been detained by the third respondent by his order in No.03/Black Marketing Act/2021 dated 12.08.2021, holding him to be a "Black Marketeer", as contemplated under section 3(1) r/w section 3(2)(b) of the Prevention of Black Marketing and Maintenance of Supplies of Essential Commodities Act, 1980. The said order is under challenge in this Habeas Corpus Petition.
