The relief sought for in the present writ petition is to direct the respondents to consider the petitioner's application dated 05.12.2012 and refund the spoiled stamps amounting to Rs.1,61,000/- to the petitioner.

2. The petitioner submitted application dated 05.12.2012 stating that the stamp purchased were unable to be utilized as the document was not executed. Therefore, he made a request to refund the spoiled stamps amounting to Rs.1,61,000/- and the said request has not been considered.

3. Thus, the respondents are directed to consider the said application dated 05.12.2012 by following the procedures as



contemplated under law and pass necessary orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The petitioner is directed to enclose a copy of the representation along with the all relevant documents and orders passed in this writ petition. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
