ORDER

In view of the fact that the pension proposals are under process and it will be submitted within a period of one week to the Accountant General of Tamil Nadu, the 5th respondent/ Accountant General of Tamil Nadu is directed to consider the proposal to be submitted by the Tahsildar and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.

3. With this direction, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
