Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records from the first respondent in Pro G.O.Ms.No.291 Labour and Employment (P1) Department dated 13.12.2013, to quash the same in so far as Diploma Holders are concerned prescribing the ratio of 1:1 at the entry level post of Junior Training Officer [JTO] and by confining only to National Trade Certificate [NTC] Holders with CTI Holders and consequently appoint the petitioners herein as Junior Training Officer [JTO] forthwith and all other consequential benefits.
