ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial
custody on 23.06.2022 for the offences punishable under Section 174 of



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Cr.P.C @ Section 306 of IPC in crime No.104 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that, due to family dispute, the petitioner herein alleged to have abused the deceased with filthy language. Thereafter, the deceased committed suicide by pouring kerosene on her and set ablaze. Hence, the complaint.

3. The petitioner is arrayed as A2, who is none other than the Mother-in-law of the deceased. Due to wordy quarrel between them, the deceased poured kerosene on herself and set ablaze. The petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 23.06.2022.

4. Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case and also the period of incarceration by the petitioner from the date of her arrest i.e., on 23.06.2022, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only)** with **two sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the



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Judicial Magistrate No.II, Mannargudi, Thiruvarur District and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. for a period of four weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**.

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
