ORDER

The Accountant General of Tamil Nadu filed a counter affidavit in W.P.No.14456 of 2014 stating that the pay of the petitioner in the said writ petition has been revised based on subsequent Government Orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.234 dated 01.06.2009 and G.O.Ms.No.23 dated 02.01.2011 and authorization was issued and the bonus increment prayed for by the writ petitioner in W.P.No.14456 of 2014 had been allowed and the grievance of the writ petitioner therein was redressed.

In view of paragraph 6 of the counter filed in W.P.No.14456 of 2014, the writ petitioner is at liberty to approach the competent authority for redressing his grievance in the manner known to law and in the event of filing any such representation, the respondents are directed to consider the same and pass appropriate orders as expeditiously as possible.

3. With this liberty, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
