The aforementioned Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed consequent to the unfortunate death of the second petitioner, N.Palanisamy, who had died on 15.04.2021. By way of the present petition, his wife M.Mallika and son P.Karthick are sought to be impleaded as further petitioners.

2. In the affidavit filed, the facts have been stated that N.Palanisamy had left behind three legal heirs, namely, his mother and his wife and son. The mother is already a party/first petitioner.

3. In view of these facts, which cannot be controverted since the petition had been filed by the wife, the petition is allowed.

4. Registry is directed to carry out necessary amendment in the main Civil Revision Petition to record the death of N.Palanisamy/second petitioner and to bring on record his legal representatives as 3rd and 4th

petitioners.
