Award (Decree) is passed accordingly. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.

The Court fee paid shall be refunded to the Plaintiff in O.S.No.360 of 2018 on the file of First Additional District and Sessions Court, Thiruvallur, in the manner provided under Section 69-A of the Tamil Nadu Court-Fees and Suits Valuation Act, 1955 and the Court Fees Act, 1870 as provided for under sub Sec.1 of Section 21 r/w 25 of LSA Act 1987 as amended in 1994.
