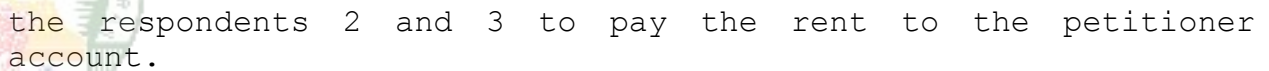

The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking issuance of Writ of Mandamus directing the first respondent to disburse the amount to the petitioner and to consequently direct



3.The further case of the petitioner is that while the petitioner's husband was alive, the petitioner's husband had let out a shop for the second respondent Bank to operate ATM and the rental amount was paid to his account. After his demise, the petitioner approached the first respondent with relevant documents and requested to permit her to operate the account/withdraw the amount, however, the first respondent failed to consider her request. Thereafter, the petitioner approached the second respondent and prayed to renew the rental agreement with the legal heirs of the deceased or in alternate to credit the rental amount in her account, however, the second respondent informed her that they are engaging the third respondent for the ATM operation, maintenance and management and directed the petitioner to approach the third respondent to redress her grievance. Accordingly, the petitioner approached the third respondent, however, the third respondent failed to consider her request. Hence, this writ petition.

5. In view of the above, this Court directs the petitioner to produce the legal heir certificate before the respondents within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. On production of the legal heir certificate by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to consider for



disbursement of the amount in favour of the petitioner, within a period of four weeks thereafter.

6.The writ petition is accordingly disposed of. No costs.
