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4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that, apart from this case, there is no previous case pending against the petitioners. However, he opposed to grant bail to the petitioners.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioners ie., from 17.07.2022, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only)** with **two blood sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **Judicial Magistrate II, Ponneri** and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b]petitioners shall report before the respondent police twice daily at 10.30.a.m., and 04.30.p.m., for a period of four weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation;



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[c] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**.

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
