PRAYER in W.P.No.18815 of 2014: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records on the file of the 2nd respondent in pursuant to the impugned result for Oral Test for recruitment to the posts included in the Combined Engineering Service Examination (2009-10 to 2012-13) published by him in his proceedings Nil dated 07.07.2014 and quash the



same as illegal, arbitrary and unjustifiable and consequently, direct the respondents to publish the result afresh including the petitioner Register Number 00205115 for Oral Test for recruitment to the posts included in the Combined Engineering Service Examination (2009-10 to 2012-13) thereby considering the petitioner's case for appointment to the post of Assistant Engineer within the time limit that may be stipulated by this Court.

PRAYER in W.P.No.19621 of 2014: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records of the third respondent dated 07.07.2014 in the candidates list for oral test/interview to the posts included in the Combined Engineering Services Examination (2009-10 to 2012-13) and quash the same and publish a fresh list of candidates as per the merit list of the candidates in the written examination.
