2.In view of the averments made that the papers in RCA, which were returned and represented was not traceable in the Registry of the Appellate Court namely, the Principal Sub-Court, Coimbatore, a report was called for from the Principal District Judge, Coimbatore. The Principal District Judge has forwarded a report by the learned Principal Sub-ordinate Judge, Coimbatore wherein, it is stated that the appeal, which was registered in CFR.No.13024 of 2018 was returned on 08.06.2018 and was represented on 20.07.2021.
