Prayer : Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a writ of Declaration, to declare the disciplinary proceedings initiated against the petitioner in respect of the punishment awarded by the order of the 2nd respondent dated 25.02.1988 made in proceedings C.No.203404/ PR.I(1)/87 have become lapsed is null and void and



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consequently direct the respondents herein to pay the retirement benefits such as Death Cum Retirement Gratuity Commutation amount (CVP), Salary, Arrears of Salary inclusive of surrender leave salary as per VI & VII Pay Commission, Enhanced Leave Salary, Terminal Leave Salary D.S.P., Addl S.P. Pay arrears, Full pension Arrears as per VI & VII Pay commission immediately with 12% interest.
