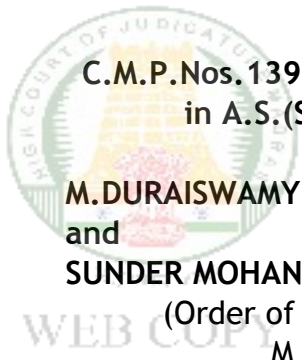

2022 is also ordered.

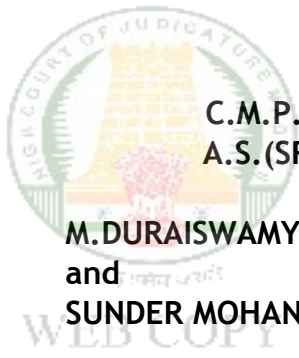
