The petitioner is the wife of the detenu viz., Naveen Kumar s/o.Sureshbabu @ Sankarappa, aged about 25 years. The detenu has been detained by the third respondent by his order in S.C.No.19/2021 (CS) dated 17.09.2021, holding him to be a "Black Marketeer", as contemplated under the Prevention of Black Marketing and Maintenance of Supplies of Essential Commodities Act, 1980 (Central Act No.7 of 1980). The said order is under challenge in this Habeas Corpus Petition.
