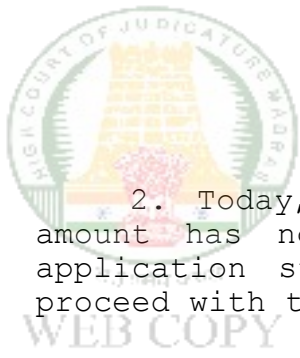

(This case has been heard through Video conference)

This Court, on the undertaking given by the petitioner that he was prepared to deposit rupees Ten lakhs to the credit of M.C.No.110 of 2016, had granted an order of interim stay and the petitioner was directed to deposit the amount within three weeks from the date of receipt of the order. Thereafter, when the matter was listed on 05.01.2022, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the copy of the order was received on 21.12.2021 and the period of three weeks gets over on 11.01.2022 and that the petitioner was taking steps to deposit the amount on or before 11.01.2022 and thereby, the matter listed today.



2. Today, it is represented by the learned counsel that the amount has not been deposited. In view of the same, the stay application stands dismissed. The Respondent is at a liberty to proceed with the Execution Proceedings
